# Guide on Applying and Removing Floor Marking Tape

## For Existing Demarcation

If the new tape is going to be installed on an existing demarcation area, the existing tape or paint will need to be removed before application.

- Remove existing paint/tape
- Scruff area and sweep up loose debris
- (If the area was painted) A coat of primer may need to be applied to ensure better adhesion from the tape

#### **Surface Preparation**



- Clean the floor with cleaner or denaturized alcohol
- Wipe floor using your standard floor cleaning method
- Allow sufficient time for wet floors to dry

## Application



**STEP 1** Fold back about 2" of the liner from the tape.



**STEP 2** Tack tape at the start point, be careful to align it in the direction desired.



#### **STEP 3**

Keep the liner in place. Pull the tape until it is stretched along with desired path.



**STEP 4** Remove backing from the tape and apply pressure evenly (preferable with a roller).

## Removal



- Using a small amount of force peel at a slow peel rate
- Keep the angle close to 90 degrees
